

Frequently Asked Questions

1. Where and when does the National Ride take place?

The Ride begins on Monday, June 9. The team will depart from Terry Fox Plaza, in front of BC Place, at 9:30 am. You can find additional route details <u>here</u>.

Riders are scheduled to arrive in St. John's on Thursday, July 10 at Terry Fox Mile 0 at approximately 3:30 pm.

- 2. Can I ride with the National team's riders?
- 3. Yes. There are two ways you can join us. Note that in both cases, you <u>must</u> be registered to participate.
 - 1. <u>Apply</u> to be a provincial team rider. The deadline to apply is March 1, 2025.
 - 2. Participate as a "ride along" rider. You can do this solo or by creating a team (with family, friends, or cycling club). <u>Register</u> and choose the "hop on" location where you'd like to join us. (See below for the location list)
