Objective

To deliver on our promise to supporters, we rely on exceptionally talented, bright, and committed people. The Warehouse Support Associate will assist the warehouse team in ensuring accurate and efficient order fulfillment. This role involves preparing, packing, and shipping school and community kits and customer orders while maintaining high standards of quality and maintaining safety.

The associate will be leveraging a software called OSA which is a standard warehouse management software (WMS) to process orders. Scanners, printers, computers will be leveraged to make the packing more efficient and allow for better inventory control. The successful candidates will be trained accordingly and required to utilize this software successfully.

The position is ideal for students or experienced workers seeking hands-on experience in supply chain and logistics operations.

Job Responsibilities

- **Product Prep:** support in preparing items like stickers, tattoos, and posters in advance of order processing.
- **Order Processing:** Pick, pack, and prepare customer orders for shipment according to company standards.
- **Shipping Coordination:** Label packages, verify shipping details, and ensure timely dispatch through designated carriers.
- **Inventory Management:** Assist with stock counts, replenishment, and maintaining organized storage areas.
- **Quality Assurance:** Inspect items for accuracy and condition before packing to minimize errors and returns.
- **Safety Compliance:** Follow all workplace health and safety guidelines, including proper handling of equipment and materials.
- **Documentation:** Complete necessary paperwork and update systems for order tracking and inventory control.
- **Team Support:** Collaborate with warehouse staff to meet daily operational targets and maintain workflow efficiency.
