Key Responsibilities

- Deliver engaging, high-energy virtual presentations to school audiences using a pre-developed multimedia presentation.
- Present alongside guest speakers, conduct interviews, and facilitate student engagement.
- Host up to 3–4 virtual presentations daily from our North York office.



- Lead post-presentation Q&A sessions and help create a memorable experience for participants.
- Learn and utilize OBS Studio and other virtual presentation platforms.
- Collaborate with the presentation moderator to ensure seamless event delivery.
- Assist with presentation preparation, platform testing, and troubleshooting as needed.
- Provide occasional administrative support, including data entry, phone support, filing, and merchandise order fulfillment.
